
Dear Prayer Partners,

We are thrilled to present a short story of the journey of Hope Haven Hospital.

The Hope Haven Hospital in Kwang, Nigeria started in 2004 as a result of preaching the Gospel in the community, to address the healthcare needs of the residents where the Haven of Hope campus is situated.



In 2004, our patient base was limited to Kwang village, but now it has grown to over 7,400. Like a mustard seed that holds the potential for growth when sown, the hospital has evolved from serving the residents of the Haven of Hope community and Jos, to providing healthcare for the entire nation. Patients now visit from various parts of the country, including Abuja, Taraba, Yobe, and Maiduguri, seeking treatment at the Haven of Hope facility.

We continue to receive countless testimonies of physical and spiritual healing, as well as exceptional healthcare from our many patients. The journey of the hospital's growth has been a long one, but it serves as a testament of God's grace through the years. We strive daily to reach new heights in providing quality health care to the patients, all to the glory of God.

We are excited to share with you God's work at the Hope Haven Hospital (HHH), Kwang.



The Hope Haven Hospital in Kwang, Nigeria stemmed from preaching the Gospel in the community. Moved by the health needs of the locals, a clinic was set up to serve those who do come to the Haven of Hope for Bible study classes and various programs.

Through the years, the Hope Haven Hospital has become a beacon of hope for its patients. This is because we are committed to not only physical healing, but also spiritual healing, focusing on the wholistic well-being of our patients by the continuous preaching of the word of God and demonstrating His love through compassionate care. We have received testimonies of salvation and hope from our patients.

HHH has also been involved in several medical outreaches beyond the Kwang community to other local governments in the state, as well as a few neighbouring states. In partnership with Joni and friends, HHH has facilitated the distribution of wheelchairs at the Haven of Hope to the physically challenged.



The Hospital hopes to expand the scope of its operation by offering specialized medical services in the future. We are grateful to God for how far He has brought us and we trust Him as we continue to demonstrate His love.



Clinic Project

We are excited to share with you some new developments from the ministry in Nigeria.

In 2023, we held an outreach in Ojali, a village in Benue State, Nigeria. We preached in the community, gave out wheelchairs to the physically challenged, and provided medical care. Being moved by the community's needs, we felt led by the Spirit to establish a clinic to continue serving the immediate community and the surrounding towns.



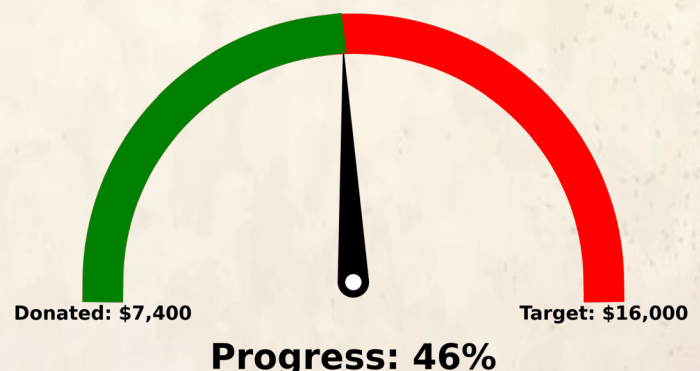
Through God's provision, we have acquired a piece of land, and plan to repurpose a 40-foot shipping container to start a clinic. This container will be transformed into consultation rooms and a pharmacy. At the moment, we are in need of a 15kVA diesel generator to power the clinic, along with solar panels to supplement the generator, due to the high cost of diesel. Additionally, we require office chairs, examination couches, hand wash basins, mini fridges, air conditioners, cabinets, rechargeable standing fans, and more.



Dr. George Ukwuoma, a board member in Nigeria, will be in charge of supervising the clinic. He resides in Otukpo, the closest city where Ojali clinic is situated.

The entire project will cost an estimated US \$16,000. Would you consider joining us in prayer for the Lord's provision for His project?

We are excited to share with you our upcoming trip to the Republic of Ghana.

In November 2024, a team consisting of Raymond, Elizabeth, and Rimamsirufun (Nigeria), visited Ghana. To build upon the work there, Raymond and Rimamsirufun will be traveling to Ghana in February 2025. Specifically we will be working in the villages near Sunyani sharing the Gospel and mentoring leaders.

To provide training to the various church leaders in different towns and communities, we will be using EvanTell, an evangelism training resource. We will also be introducing the Emmaus Bible courses, hoping to raise and train more correctors and coordinators for that region of the country.



All these trainings are designed to equip leaders with the necessary tools and knowledge for effective ministry within their various churches, their respective communities, and workplaces.

We are thrilled to share with you God's transformative work in Nigeria through the Hope Haven Water project.

As part of our commitment to reaching out to communities in Nigeria with the Gospel of Christ, we were moved by the needs, one of which is clean water. Clean accessible water, a fundamental necessity, is often a scarce item in many parts of Nigeria. IOI has helped provide water wells for several communities in the North-central part of Nigeria, where this need is most prevalent.



In 2006, IOI received a generous donation, an ultra-filtration water machine, the first of its kind in Nigeria, and all of West Africa. This incredible gift marked the beginning of our water factory, a beacon of hope and health in our community and beyond. For over a decade, this machine has been the heart of our operation. It has tirelessly purified water for the residents of the Kwang community, where the Haven of Hope is located and beyond. Every day, individuals from the community come to the Haven of Hope, our central hub, to collect fresh, clean water.



Beyond this direct community outreach, our factory also produces sachet water in 50cl sizes, which is sold within the city of Jos. What sets the Hope Haven Water factory apart is our mission-driven approach. Unlike commercial ventures, our primary goal is not profit, but reaching out to our people. We offer our water at a price significantly lower than market rates, ensuring that clean, potable drinking water is accessible to all, especially those who struggle to afford it.

We are thrilled to share with you about our recent trip to Ghana.



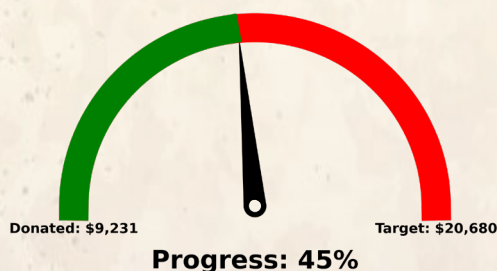

God graciously provided willing volunteer medical professionals to join us in this endeavor. Medical consultations were provided, and medications were given, tailored to everyone's specific medical needs. We thank God for the success of the outreach and testimonies of lives touched by compassionate care and healing.



We also observed in Isakrom that the villagers had a great need for clean drinking water, as their main source of water is a muddy stream. Please join us in prayer as we seek the Lord's guidance on how we may be able to help with this water crisis.

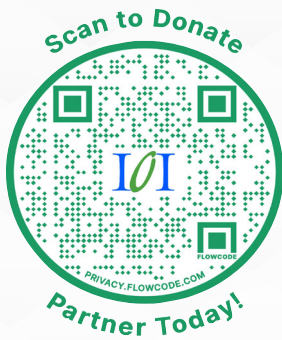
