Dear Prayer Partners,

We are excited to share with you another testimony of what God is doing through the Hope Haven Hospital.



In February 2026, Hope Haven Hospital, in partnership with Restoring Power Global Assembly, carried out a medical outreach in Dikibin, a remote interior village in Plateau State, Nigeria. This outreach was both a spiritual and medical mission. The Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ was faithfully preached, and many listened keenly. Counselling sessions were held, and Christian literature was distributed to those who attended.

The medical needs in the community were significant; residents lack access to basic healthcare services. Through the dedication of the medical team and volunteers, residents received medical consultations, laboratory investigations, diagnoses, and appropriate medications — at no cost to them. By the grace of God, over 400 people benefited from this outreach. The joy and gratitude expressed by the community were deeply moving. Many gave thanks to God for remembering their village, and they sincerely appreciated the volunteers who sacrificed their time and resources to serve them.



We are profoundly grateful to God for the safety of all volunteers, especially considering the present insecurity situation in Plateau State. This outreach was not only an opportunity to meet physical needs but also a reminder that the love of Christ reaches even the most remote places.

Please join us in praying that:

- Those who received the Lord Jesus Christ as Saviour will grow in faith and continue steadfastly in Him
- The residents will apply the health education shared during the outreach
- The Lord will protect the community from the activities of bandits and terrorists, restoring lasting peace to the community and the state at large
- Further doors for ministry will open in Dikibin and the surrounding communities

TYPICAL MEDICAL OUTREACH COST

A typical medical outreach in Africa costs about \$2,000 (USD) for 100 people.

The cost includes: medical evaluations and medication, along with supplies such as rice, fish, sugar, cooking oil, and bathing soap.



Dear Prayer Partners,

We are excited to share an update from the recent Nigerian Mission Exposure.

The Nigeria Mission Exposure was scheduled to be held from March 26th to April 13th, 2026. Our initial itinerary was centred on attending the Nigerian Brethren Conference and hosting the Emmaus Leaders Conference, opportunities designed to strengthen fellowship, equip leaders, and advance the Gospel in Nigeria. However, these plans were suddenly disrupted by a tragic attack on a Christian community in Jos on Palm Sunday, March 29th, resulting in the loss of many lives. In light of the unfolding situation, adjustments had to be made.



Consequently, Fred Konadu returned to Ghana, while Raymond, Jennifer, and Abigail relocated first to Abuja and later to Lagos to continue the mission work. Even amid these changes, God opened doors for fruitful ministry. On Easter Sunday, Raymond had the privilege of encouraging the saints in Lagos. Through it all, we give thanks to the Lord for His faithfulness. Though the journey looked different from what we anticipated, we are reminded that He “... **works all things according to the counsel of His will**” (Ephesians 1:11). His purposes cannot be thwarted, and His grace has been evident even in the redirection.

We ask you to continue standing with us in prayer that:

- God’s divine protection will surround the brethren in Nigeria, keeping them safe amid the present security challenges and threats of violence
- The Lord will strengthen and encourage His people with fresh hope, boldness, and resilience to continue advancing His Kingdom work without fear
- Comfort and healing will flow to all who lost loved ones in the attacks

We are excited to share with you about the recent wheelchair distribution held at the Haven of Hope.

Over the years, IOI in partnership with Joni and Friends has facilitated the distribution of wheelchairs and mobility aids to individuals living with disabilities across Nigeria. For nearly a decade, this collaboration has transformed the lives of hundreds of individuals and their families, which is a demonstration of God's love to them. On April 11th, 2026, we distributed wheelchairs and walking aids to fifty beneficiaries.



While over a hundred individuals had initially been screened for this outreach, prevailing security challenges in the state made it difficult for some to travel to the Haven of Hope. Despite these limitations, the outreach was deeply impactful. Beyond the distribution of mobility aids, the Word of God was shared, bringing encouragement and spiritual nourishment to all present. It was a time not only of physical provision but also of eternal significance. Beneficiaries and their families expressed heartfelt gratitude for this act of compassion.

For many, this gift represents more than mobility—it restores dignity, creates new opportunities, and serves as a tangible reminder of God's care for them. We praise God for the success of this outreach and for the safety of everyone involved, especially given the fragile security situation in the country. We look forward to reaching out to many others with mobility as the Lord enables us.

We are excited to share with you another testimony of what the Lord is doing as we seek to equip believers to boldly proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In January and February 2026, we had the privilege of conducting Evantell evangelism training in some churches in Plateau State, Nigeria. These gatherings brought together believers who desired to become more effective witnesses for Christ in their everyday lives. Participants were taught practical ways to share the message of salvation in a clear, simple, and biblical manner, so that anyone—whether a neighbour, friend, colleague, or stranger—can understand the good news of Jesus Christ.



The training emphasised that evangelism is not reserved for a selected few but is the calling and privilege of every believer. By the grace of God, over 200 individuals participated in these trainings, including church leaders and representatives from various congregations. The response from participants has been encouraging. Many testified that the training helped remove fear and uncertainty about evangelism, replacing it with clarity and confidence for reaching the lost. Several shared how grateful they were for the opportunity to be equipped in such a practical and spiritually enriching way.

We are especially encouraged by the hunger and willingness of believers to be trained. The harvest is indeed plentiful, and through these trainings, we are trusting God to raise more labourers for His harvest field. We are grateful to the Lord for the doors He has opened through these Evantell trainings and for the lives that are being prepared to take the Gospel further.

School Construction Update

Haven of Hope Academy, Nigeria

Dear Prayer Partners,

We are glad to bring you an update about the Haven of Hope Academy (HHA) school construction.

The HHA school construction has been going on for a while. Through God's continued provision, the work on the new school building is moving forward steadily. From our last report, the second floor was partially completed and in use. Hence, the school was able to admit more students last session. Currently, work is ongoing on the ground floor, which is the primary focus of the construction team. The ground floor houses offices, as well as the key laboratories: Chemistry, Biology, Physics, Agriculture, and Computer/E-library.



We are currently upgrading the electrical circuits to ensure the Computer lab and E-Library can safely handle a high power load. Network and ICT infrastructure are also progressing well, and much of the underground conduit work for internet and communication systems are already in place. Internal wall plastering is about 95% complete, with only a small portion remaining. Tiling on the ground floor has not yet begun because plumbing, electrical, and network installations must first be completed properly.



From the recent entrance exams, we have many students who are interested in coming to our school. Our goal is to have the ground floor completed and ready for use by September 2026, when the new school session begins. While important tasks remain, significant progress has been made throughout the building.

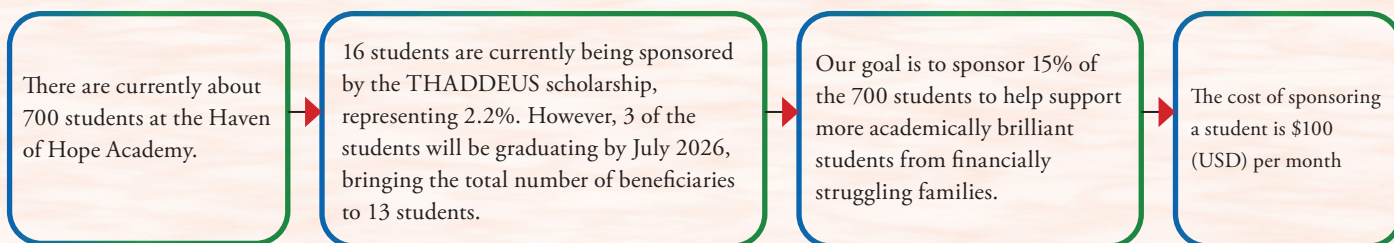

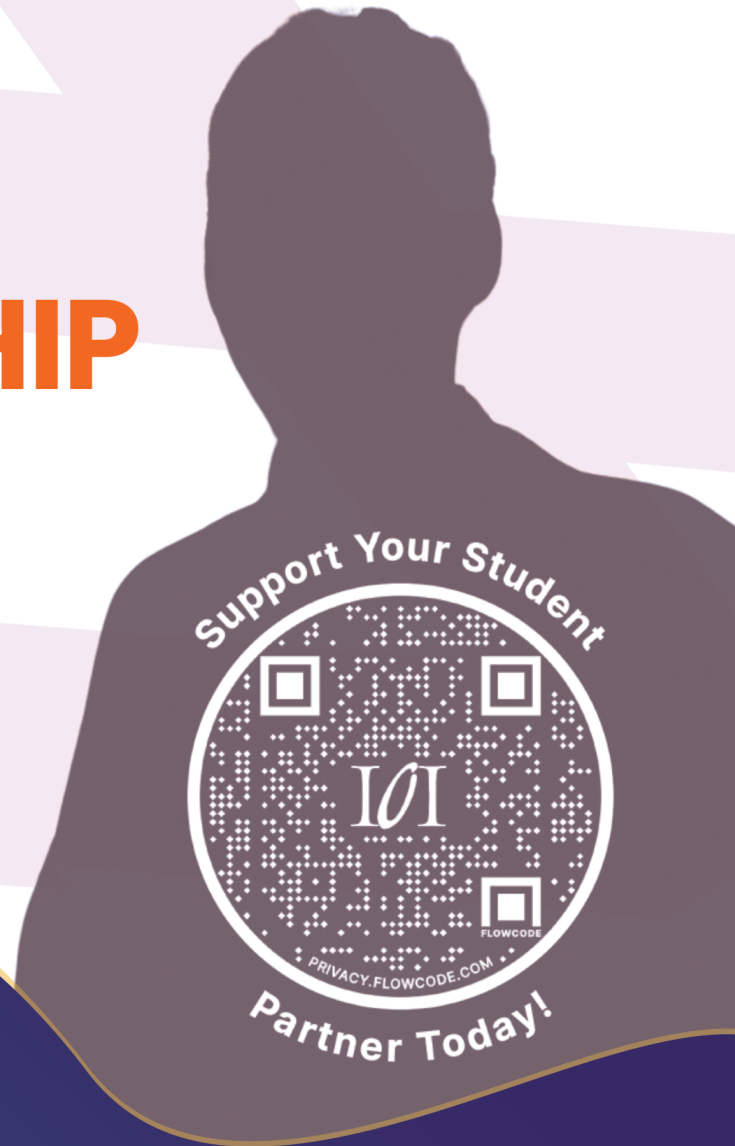
